

Basic Program Workflow

You can think of your services like a hike, with each program as a separate trail. Filling out this sheet will help get you prepared for deeper dives into the details of each program, but first we need to know the details of the trail.

Program Name: What's the Trail?

Example: Foster to Adopt

Program Client: Who's Hiking?

Example: Youth in foster care interested in adoption with parental rights terminated.

Beginning Point: How Does the Hike Start?

Example: Youth is referred to our organization as a potential foster-to-adopt candidate.

End Point: Where's the Finish Line?

Example: Youth is adopted, OR youth is no longer interested in adoption, OR parental rights are reinstated, OR youth turns 18.

Service Providers: Who are the Guides and Sherpas (Staff and Community Partners)?

Example: Social workers, potential families, permanency specialists, county social services, Heart Gallery coordinator, community mentors, school representatives.
